Annual Report (2021-2022)

The following is the Brief Report all curricular and Co-Curricular activities, which were organized between 11th October 2021 to.

The college re-opened on **11th October 2021** for the academic year 2021-2022.

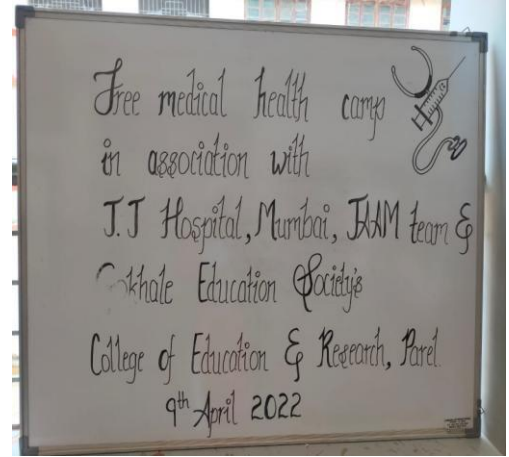
Anil More Sir talked about how we learn many things from pandemic period, the importance of life and importance of relationship.

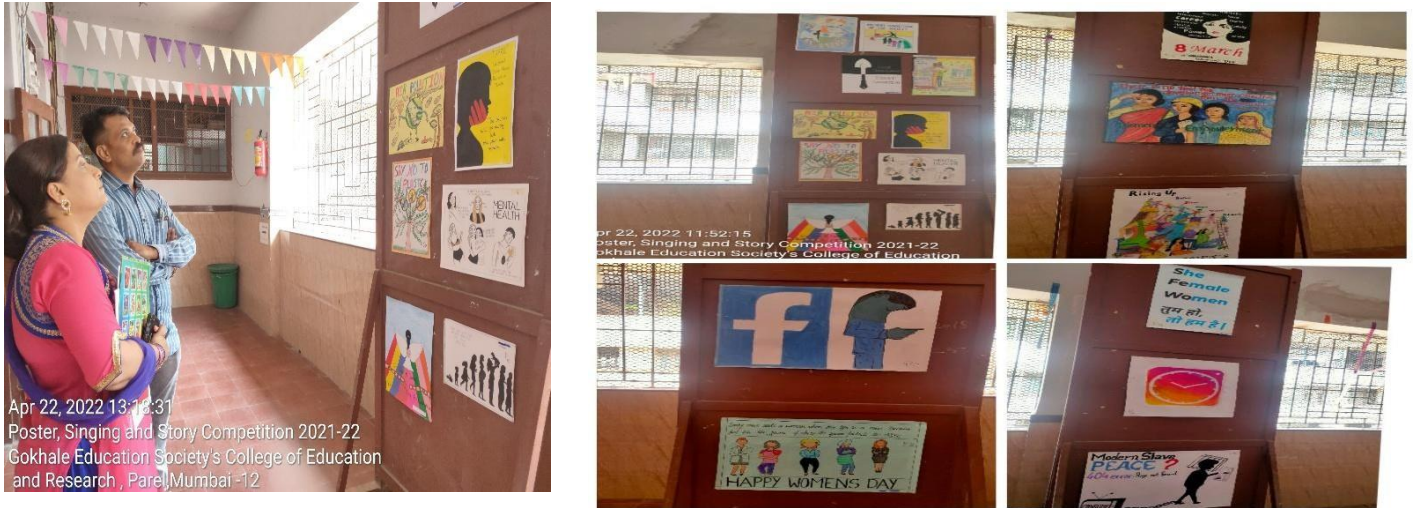
After 5 minutes break, the next event that started was the story telling competition. This competition too had the same rule that no writing material was allowed and maximum time limit was of 5 minutes.

On the same floor, through many models, the entire life journey of Mahatma Gandhi has been shown. The models are housed in small wooden cases. The college organized a one-day workshop on 'Understanding Pedagogical Content Knowledge (PCK)' on October 13, 2022, at Integrated Laboratory HBCSE-TIFR, Mankhurd. The reporting time was 10:20 am and almost all the students came on time. The workshop began at 10:30 am. The first event was on Understanding PCK and was presented by Dr. Narendra D Deshmukh. Before this, he gave us all a brief introduction about HBCSE and when it was established, the purpose of the institute, and all the activities and academics there.

Then, he explained to us about PCK i.e. Pedagogical Content Knowledge, and how it is integrated with TPCK i.e. Techno-Pedagogical Content Knowledge. This was done through an engaging PowerPoint Presentation. He explained the model of PCK by Schulman, teacher knowledge base components identified as part of PCK, and the approach from Pedagogical Content Knowledge (PCK) to Topic Specific Pedagogical Content Knowledge TSPCK, and also shared with us the various references. Then, we were asked to form groups according to our subjects and to present on any topic with respect to the TSPCK model (Mavhunga and Rollnick 2013). Accordingly, 6 groups were formed and were given time to discuss and reflect. Then, one member of each group presented their discussions. After each presentation, Narendra Sir gave his insights as well.

All dispersed for a lunch break around 12:50 pm. I must admit, the lunch in the canteen was tasty! Then we all assembled back after the short break at around 1:45 pm.

Then, Ms. Sonali Kanthale started the next session on the topic 'Heat'. She first gave three items made of different materials to all the groups and also gave a questionnaire. All the students solved the same and then the answers were discussed. The concept of exchange of heat and intermolecular distance was clarified and related to the actual process of heating up of land and water.
