S.Y.B.Ed student teachers participated in I for Inclusion workshop. It was organized by Dr Prashant Kale in coordination with Xavier's Resource Centre for the Visually Challenged (XRCVC). It was a three days workshop from 2nd May 2023 to 4th May 2023.

The resource person, Poonam mam asked some questions to understand the workshop. What are the things you believe that a student with a disability cannot do? What is the main reason you think they cannot do these things? These answers were not disclosed at this time. Interesting activities took place such as blindfolded games and making new groups. Identify the note/coin, ingredient, shape etc was conducted. Introduction of individuals was also taken during this activity. Through this activity individuals are important; you are unique in your own way, disability doesn't stop you from learning was taught to us. Mathematical games, writing with the help of the left hand and word games were conducted.

On the second day, Visual impairment and teaching aids used for it were explained by Poonam mam. Screen reader, screen magnifier, video magnifier, visuals and graphics; how they are used as teaching learning aids was demonstrated. Hearing impairment and use of technology that provide Visual, tactile and auditory warnings to a deaf person for safety emergencies was explained through presentation. Various websites for learning and practice were shared to improve the skills of students. Lastly, writing your name in braille activity was taken by Suzan mam. On the third day, ten principles of Inclusion, Individualized lesson plan was explained by Dr. Kasturi Kulkarni. One visually challenged person interacted with us about his daily life experiences. Teaching tips in class, specific learning disabilities; knowing how students are unique, assisting technology, Learning through case study and presentation of the same was conducted. Overall the workshop was successful with splendid learning.
